Kinesiology Awards Descriptions and Requirements

Lucille M. Swift Honor Award

This award recognizes superior scholarship and professional promise in two student. The students shall be one senior who has maintained a GPA of 3.0 or higher in Sophomore and Junior years and one graduate student with at least a 6.75 GPA on a 9.0 scale. These students shall have worked approximately 20 hours per week for support or have been on work-study.

Laurie Campbell Award

This award recognizes one outstanding female student majoring in Physical Education.

Phebe Martha Scott Achievement Award

This award recognizes one outstanding female who is outgoing, friendly and helpful, involved in campus and sports activities, and is beginning her senior year in Physical Education or a related field.

Stan Kemp Scholarship

Each year, this award recognizes five or six students, who are juniors, seniors, or graduate students and demonstrate high character, integrity, idealism, leadership, scholarship.

This Memorial recognizes one graduate student and one undergraduate student who have demonstrated superior scholarship and professional zeal and promise.
