

## **Kinesiology GSRA Non-resident Tuition Costs Policy**

In order to assist faculty in supporting doctoral students on federal grant proposals, the School will provide the following support for a GSRA budgeted on a grant proposal for a 30%, 12-month appointment (or higher):

1. Non-resident tuition differential.
2. A percentage of the 12 month stipend, which is determined by the ICR rate associated with the proposal. If the ICR rate is 54.5%, then 54.5% of stipend would be covered by Kinesiology.
3. Difference between federal tuition rate charged to the grant and the actual Kinesiology tuition.

*Example: 2008-2009 rates for a 50% non-resident GSRA*

	<u>Sponsor</u>	<u>Kinesiology</u>
Stipend	10,968	13,137
Fall and Winter Tuition	17,768	18,382
Spring Tuition	4,442	4,595
Fringes	<u>2,436</u>	<u>0</u>
Total	35,614	36,114

Notes:

- a. The above guidelines do not apply to additional GSRA's.
- b. The above guidelines do not apply to sponsors with ICR rates below the federal agency level.
