- **Book Manuscript Summary:** This manuscript concerns sport as public pedagogy that inculcates an aspiration of multicultural identities (i.e., post-raciality along with colorblindness) while facilitating racial formation of Asian diaspora. I contend that sport is a cultural domain in which signifies multiculturalist white supremacist logic of sociality and raciality, racial capitalism, and sincere fictions of the US empire. Using youth ice hockey as an optic, I conducted multi-sited ethnography and cultural analysis in order to explore the racial formation of Korean immigrants and Korean Americans within the midwestern your ice hockey communities.
