Dr. Dae Hee Kwak, Associate Professor in Sport Management in the School of Kinesiology, and the Director of Center for Sport Marketing Research (<u>www.csmar.kines.umich.edu</u>) at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, **is currently seeking a dedicated and motivated Doctoral Student to work on research related to sport consumer behavior and consumer psychology for Fall 2020!** 

Dr. Kwak's research focuses on examining various psychological factors that affect sport consumers' decision making and behavior across sport-related consumption settings such as sponsorship, athlete endorsement, sport betting, etc. He has published more than 30 articles in peer-reviewed journals and he also received multiple awards, including the Research Fellow Award (North American Society for Sport Management) and the Faculty Research Excellence Award (School of Kinesiology). - The selected student will begin the PhD program in **Fall 2020** and will be provided with full funding for tuition, a living stipend and health care (student/family) as a Graduate Student Instructor (GSI). The GSI assistantship will cover four years of doctoral study.
- The selected student will be affiliated with the Center for Sport Marketing Research and will be involved in several ongoing projects.
